

Dr. Niaz Asadullah joins the Department of Economics, NSU as an Honorary Professorial Fellow

We are pleased to announce that, this Spring, Dr M Niaz Asadullah joins us as Honorary Professorial Fellow at the Department of Economics. Currently a Professor of Economics at Monash University, Malaysia, Dr Asadullah holds a Ph.D. from the University of Oxford, UK. He is also the Southeast Asia Lead of the Global Labor Organization (GLO) and a Fellow of the IZA Institute of Labor Economics.

Thus far, his research has focused on topics related to gender inequality (child marriage, gender stereotypes), education (madrasas, NGO schools) labor (migration, skills, women's work), well-being (happiness, life satisfaction) and governance (corruption, state capacity) in South Asia and ASEAN.

Additionally, he has served as the co-editor of several peer reviewed journals including Singapore Economic Review, PLOS One, and International Journal of Educational Development. He was also on the Editorial Board of several Web of Science/SCOPUS journals such as Feminist Economics, Poverty & Public Policy, Journal of Public Affairs.
