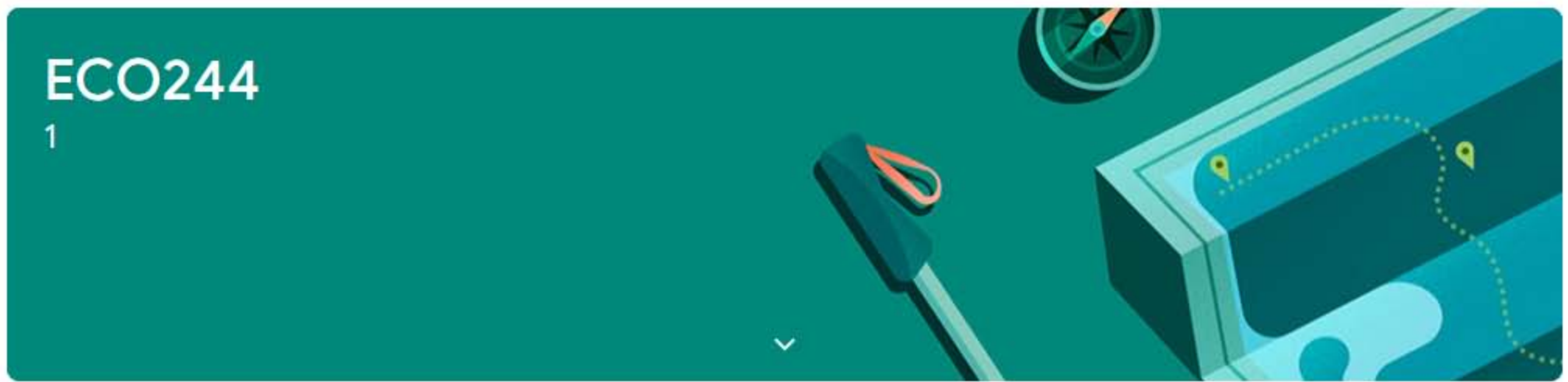

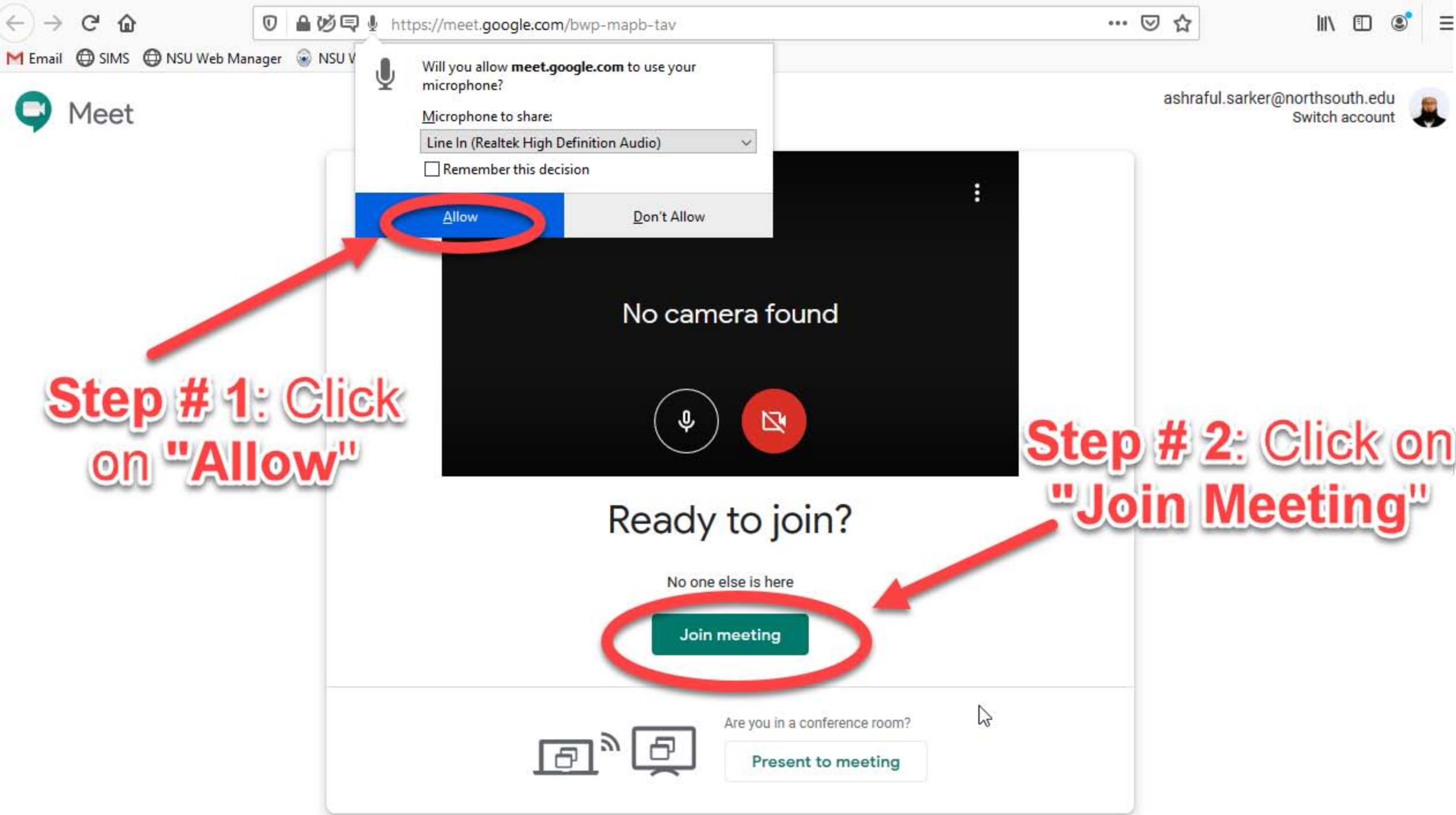

Step # 2: Click on "Join Meeting"



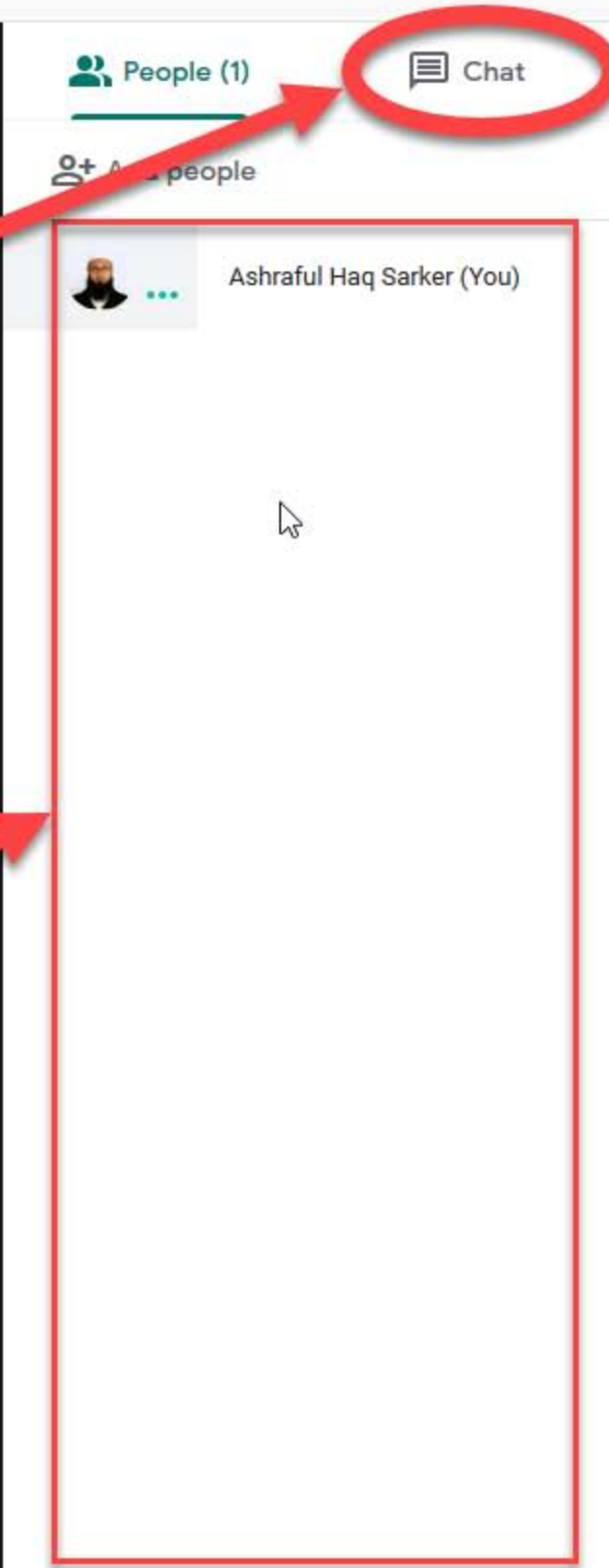


