Advising Process – Summer 2024

Advising will be in three phases and the procedure remains the same.

- 1. Pre-advising is mandatory and it ends on June 23, 2024.
- 2. Faculty evaluation is mandatory for Phase 1 advising.
- 3. All payments must be clear by June 20, 2024, to be considered for Phase 1.
- 4. All students will have slots including probation (1 to 3), but it will be conditional.
- 5. Probation 4 and above students will be allowed conditionally from Phase 2.
- 6. Reasons for disqualification from advising:
 - ➤ Missing pre-advising
 - Payment is due or not completed as of June 20, 2024.
 - Missing faculty evaluation.
 - > Student missed advising for 2 or more consecutive semesters without permission.
 - Unauthorized semester drops.

Phase 1 - Pre-advised based advising: (June 30, 2024 – July 2, 2024)

- 1. Advising will be based on students' pre-advising selections.
- 2. Students can add, drop, and change sections accordingly.
- 3. Each student will have two slots per day.

Phase 2 - Slotless advising (July 3, 2024 – July 4, 2024)

- 1. There are no pre-fixed slots in this phase unlike Phase 1. It's an equal opportunity for all. A dynamic slot could be imposed if the student number exceeds a certain limit.
- 2. Pre-advising restriction will be removed. All courses will be visible to all students.
- 3. Students can add, drop, and section change

Phase 3 – Drop less advising (July 9, 2024 – July 13, 2024)

- 1. Advising will remain open for all students except for the Freshman.
- 2. Course drop is strictly prohibited.
- 3. Section change is allowed.
