## **Advising Process – Summer 2025**

Advising will be in three phases and the procedure remains the same.

- 1. Pre-advising is mandatory and it ends on May 05, 2025.
- 2. Faculty evaluation is mandatory for Phase 1 advising.
- 3. All payments must be clear by Apr 24, 2025, to be considered for Phase 1.
- 4. All students will have slots including probation (1 to 3), but it will be conditional.
- 5. Probation 4 and above students will be allowed conditionally from Phase 2.
- 6. Reasons for disqualification from advising:
  - ➤ Missing pre-advising
  - Payment is due or not completed as of Apr 24, 2025.
  - Missing faculty evaluation.
  - > Student missed advising for 2 or more consecutive semesters without permission.
  - Unauthorized semester drops.

## Phase 1 Advising: (May 12, 2025 – May 13, 2025)

- 1. Advising will be based on students' pre-advising selections (Pre-advised based)
- 2. Students can add, drop, and change sections accordingly.
- 3. Each student will have two slots per day.

## Phase 2 Advising: (May 14, 2025 – May 17, 2025)

- 1. There are no pre-fixed slots in this phase unlike Phase 1. It's an equal opportunity for all. A dynamic slot could be imposed if the student number exceeds a certain limit.
- 2. Pre-advising restriction will be removed. All courses will be visible to all students.
- 3. Students can add, drop, and section change

## Phase 3 Advising: ((May 20, 2025 – May 29, 2025))

- 1. Can view all offered courses Open to all students except freshmen
- 2. Advising schedule will be automatically generated based on available time slots
- 3. Course Add and Section Change are allowed
- 4. Course Drop allowed through RDS (after payment completion)
- 5. Cannot Add any course that was dropped after payment via RDS
