Notice Regarding Restriction on GED Course Enrollment for Law Students in Fall Semester (Trimester)

Dear Students of the LL.B. program,

This notice serves as a formal reiteration of the academic framework governing the Department of Law at North South University (NSU). As you are aware, the Department of Law operates under a bi-semester system, comprising only Spring (from January to June) and Summer semesters (from July to December) per academic year. This structure has been instituted in strict compliance with the prevailing legal framework of the country (Bangladesh Bar Council/University Grant Commission/Bangladesh Supreme Court).

Accordingly, **LL.B. students are expressly prohibited from enrolling in any GED courses during the Fall Trimester (Sep to Dec)**. GED courses are administered by other departments at NSU, which adhere to a tri-semester academic system [Spring (Jan-April), Summer (May-Aug), and Fall (Sep-Dec)]. Fall (Sep-Dec) trimester shall remain available exclusively to non-law students. Any attempt by LL.B. students to enroll in GED courses during the Fall semester in future may result in serious academic conflicts, undermining the structural integrity of the Law Department's curriculum.

It is imperative to note that this directive is not a new policy being circulated but a formal reiteration, as multiple prior notifications have already been circulated via email to all law students. Failure to comply with this directive may give rise to academic complications, including potential impediments to individual accreditation by the Bar Council, for which the Department of Law shall bear no responsibility.
